Bank Al-Maghrib puts into circulation new 200 dirham banknote

Rabat, January 12th, 2024

As part of issuing the new series of banknotes and coins, Bank Al-Maghrib is putting into circulation a new 200 dirham banknote as of today, Friday, January 12th, 2024, timed to coincide with the celebration of the 80th anniversary of the Manifesto of Independence.

The new 200 dirham banknote highlights the economic and industrial development achieved under the guidance of His Majesty King Mohammed VI. The themes chosen for the banknote's graphic illustrations are infrastructure, industry and development.

The front of the banknote features a portrait of His Majesty King Mohammed VI, the Kingdom's coat of arms and a depiction of the "Mohammed VI" cable-stayed bridge. As for the reverse, it shows a stylised view of "Mohammed VI" Tower and "Marrakech-Menara" International Airport, as well as designs symbolizing the development of industry and digital technology in Morocco.

This new banknote incorporates the most advanced technologies in terms of security features, such as the security thread with three-dimensional dynamic effect, the color-shifting magnetic ink, the see through feature, the tactile relief for the visually impaired, micro-texts as well as typography with progressive characters.

All the design and manufacturing process for the new series of banknotes and coins were carried out exclusively by Moroccan experts operating within Dar As-Sikkah.
