Bank Al-Maghrib and the Central Bank of Djibouti sign cooperation agreement

Washington D.C., October 14, 2017

Bank Al-Maghrib and the Central Bank of Djibouti signed on Friday, October 14, 2017, a General Cooperation Agreement aimed to establish a formal framework for bilateral relations and to strengthen cooperation and partnership between the two institutions.

This agreement is part of the common desire of the two central banks to deepen the sharing of experiences, particularly in the areas of monetary policy, banking supervision, financial stability, and the fight against money laundering and the financing of terrorism.

The agreement was signed in by Mr. Abdellatif Jouahri, Governor of Bank Al-Maghrib, and Mr. Ahmed Osman Ali, Governor of the Central Bank of Djibouti, on the sidelines of their participation in the Annual Meetings of the International Monetary Fund and the World Bank in Washington D.C.
