As part of its 60th anniversary celebrations, Bank Al-Maghrib and the «Econometric Society» organize the 2019 Africa Meeting of the Econometric Society.

Founded in 1930 by Ragnar Frisch, winner of the first Nobel Prize in Economics, the «Econometric Society» is considered as one of the most prestigious economic institutions.

The purpose of this event is to create a space for exchange and constructive debate for the advancement of economic theory in its relation to statistics and mathematics. This edition will be attended by high officials representing national and international institutions, as well as the academia and the private sector.

The program of the meeting includes plenary sessions led by high-level speakers, including the 2011 Nobel Prize winner, Professor Christopher Sims.

During this event, prominent experts of the Moroccan economy will also be brought together in a session to discuss the "New Moroccan development model and Economic integration in Africa".

In addition, parallel sessions will be dedicated to presenting around a hundred research papers submitted by researchers from around the globe (England, Belgium, Canada, Chile, South Korea, United States of America, Egypt, Spain, France, Italy, Japan, Kenya, Luxembourg, Morocco, Nigeria, Netherlands, Qatar, Senegal, Switzerland, Tunisia, ...).
