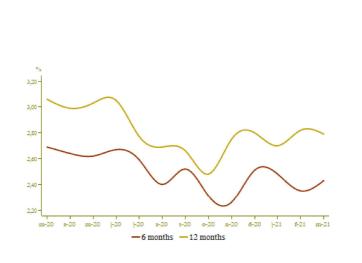

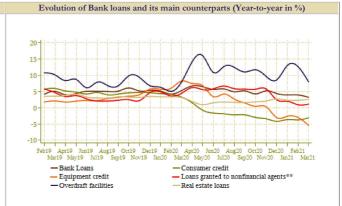
MONETARY AND LIQUID INVESTMENT AGGREGATES

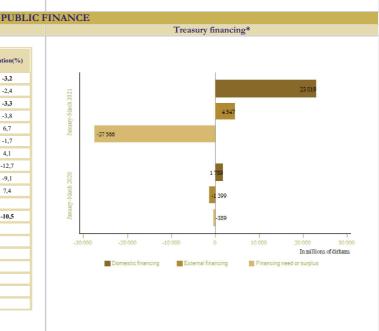

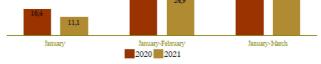

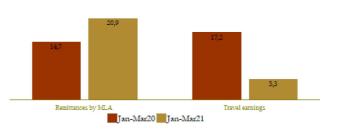
