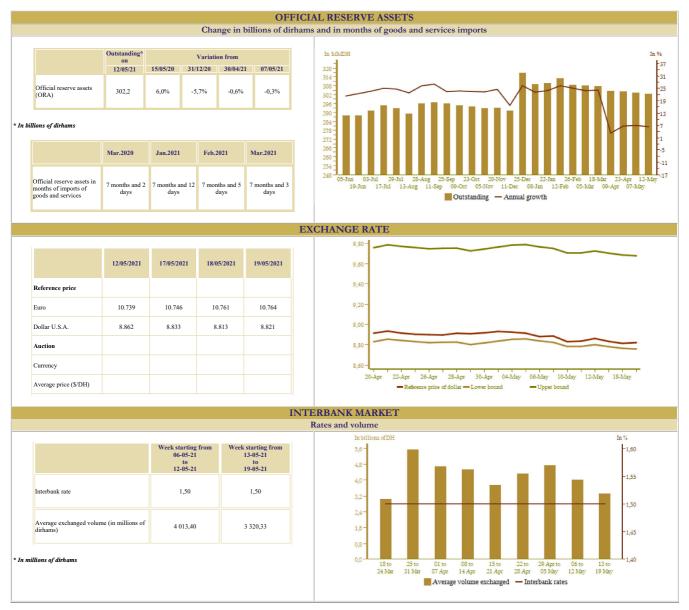
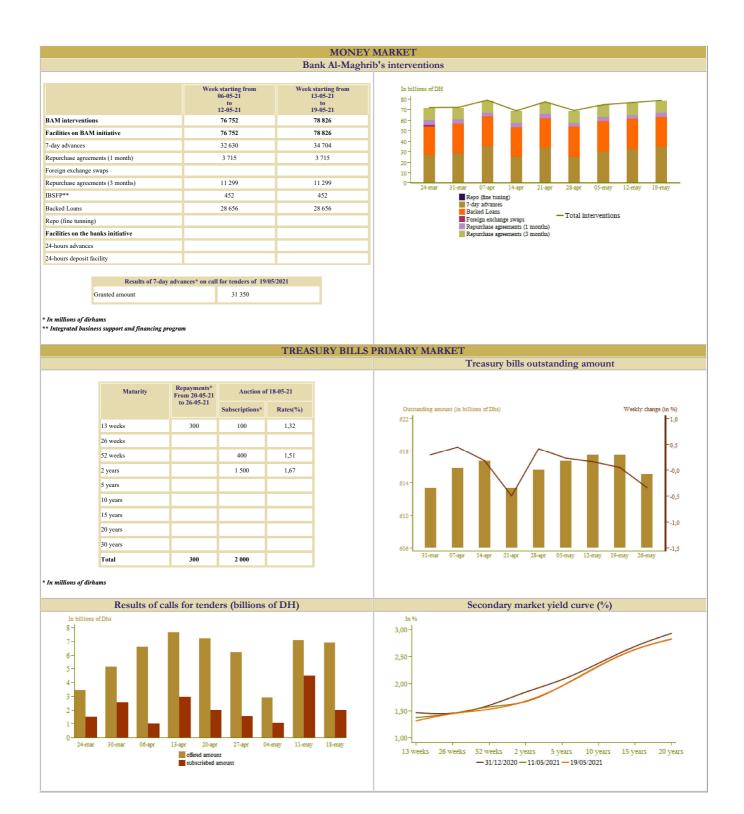

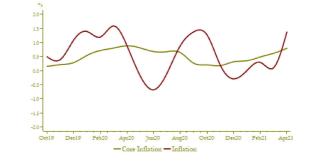




Year-on-year evolution of inflation

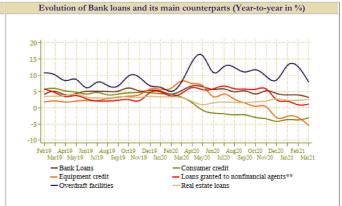

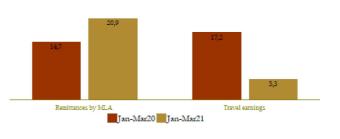
