Bank Al-Maghrrib puts into circulation new 50 dirham banknote

Rabat, July 30th, 2024

As part of issuing the new series of banknotes, Bank Al-Maghrrib is putting into circulation a new 50 dirham banknote as of today, Tuesday July 30th, 2024, timed to coincide with the celebration of the 25th anniversary of the enthronement of His Majesty King Mohammed VI.

The new 50 dirham banknote highlights sustainable development in Morocco through the national strategy related to clean energies and the protection of natural resources. The front side of the banknote features the portrait of His Majesty King Mohammed VI, the Kingdom's coat of arms, architectural pattern inspired from Moroccan portals and stylized view of the Ouzoud Falls. The back side shows a stylized view of «NOOR» solar power plant in Ouarzazate, wind turbines, Ouirgane dam and Agadir seawater desalination plant.

This new banknote incorporates the most advanced technologies in terms of security features, such as the security thread with dynamic color-shift effect, the iridescent ink, the see through design, the tactile relief for the visually impaired as well as numbering with progressive characters.

All the design and production process for this new banknote were carried out exclusively by Moroccan experts of Dar As-Sikkah.
